## BISHOP'S MESSAGE FOR APRIL 2022

**The Core Event of our Hope:** The resurrection of Jesus is the fundamental event upon which the Christian faith rests (cf. 1 Cor 15:14). In fact, “all time belongs to [Christ] and all the ages”, as the evocative liturgy of the Easter Vigil recalls in preparing the Paschal Candle. The Paschal Mystery points to Jesus’ victory over sin and death, and it also reminds us of the consummation of all history in the final coming of the Redeemer. The feast of Easter reminds us of facing towards the East. It means that when one prays, one is turned toward the rising sun, which is pointing to the risen Christ. It also connects to the New City, whose light is God himself. After his crucifixion, Jesus rose on the third day, and he sanctified the first day of the week. Every Sunday is, therefore, the weekly Easter celebration and those who have received the grace of faith in the Risen Lord cannot fail to grasp the significance of this day of the week with the same deep emotion which led Saint Jerome to say: “Sunday is the day of the Resurrection, it is the day of Christians, it is our day”. It is unfortunate that due to the pandemic, many have given up the participation in the Liturgy on Sundays. Christ still lives, and his resurrection gives us the strength to live our daily lives. This is the centre of our hope. Let us do all that is possible to bring people back to the risen Christ and encounter him during the Sunday Liturgy.

**The Holy Week** is replete with intense meaning and significance. The overarching of triumph from Palm Sunday with the entry of Jesus into Jerusalem to new triumph of rising from the dead unites the human and divine reality of Jesus. While in the Holy Week, we contemplate the humanity and suffering of Jesus, the Easter Sunday changes the whole mood into joy of the manifestation of his divinity. Every day of the Triduum invites us to contemplate the great truth of our redemption. The Jewish Paschal Meal is transformed into Eucharistic banquet, the crucifixion and death of Jesus becomes the moment of the glorification as he accomplishes the plan of the Father, doing his will to the finest point, the Holy Saturday, spent in silent meditation

of his death and the lively Easter Vigil, which is considered as the “Mother of all Vigils” in which the Church keeping watch, awaits the Resurrection of Christ and celebrates it in the Sacraments. The night is the most suitable time for the celebration of the Vigil, where Christ turns our darkness into light. Let this year’s Holy Week be for us an occasion to experience the transformation from darkness of hatred to the light of love. St. Paul reminds us: “And if Christ has not been raised, your faith is vain” (1 Cor 15:17). And if he had not been raised, his teachings would have resulted in nothing, and his promises would not have been fulfilled. But the Lord is alive, he walks by our side, and he reminds us, through the Easter liturgy, that pain and death are not the last word for us. That is why we must rejoice and full of joy sing with the psalmist: “This is the day the Lord has made, let us rejoice in it and be glad” (Ps 118:24). Let us repeat prayerfully what St Augustine proclaimed in the uncertain times in which he lived: “We are Easter people, and ‘Alleluia’ is our song.”

**Divine Mercy Sunday** (also known as the Feast of the Divine Mercy) is celebrated on the Second Sunday of Easter, which concludes the Octave of Easter. This year, it is on 24 April 2022. In a decree dated 3 August 2002, the Apostolic Penitentiary announced that in order “to ensure that the faithful would observe this day (Divine Mercy Sunday) with intense devotion, the Supreme Pontiff established that this Sunday be enriched by a plenary indulgence ... so that the faithful might receive in abundance the gift of the consolation of the Holy Spirit. In this way, they can foster a growing love for God and for their neighbour, and after they have obtained God’s pardon, they, in turn, might be persuaded to show a prompt pardon to their brothers and sisters.”

The plenary indulgence is granted under the usual conditions (sacramental confession, Eucharistic communion and prayer for the intentions of Supreme Pontiff) to the faithful who, on the Second Sunday of Easter or Divine Mercy Sunday, in any church or chapel, in a spirit that is completely detached from the affection for a sin, even a venial sin, take part in the prayers and devotions held in honour of Divine Mercy, or who, in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament exposed or reserved in the tabernacle, recite the Our Father and the Creed, adding a devout prayer to the merciful Lord Jesus (e.g. Merciful Jesus, I trust in you!).

**Priest, a Servant of the Sacred Liturgy:** While we celebrate the various moments of the Holy Week, we are careful to follow the instructions given in the Roman Missal and in the Liturgical Calendar (*Ordo*). However, during the year, there seems to be a tendency to celebrate according to convenience, by changing certain expressions, or replacing some parts with our own words. If a certain provision is made to give introduction, the priest must use those moments judiciously. However, the Roman Missal itself admonishes the priest that he has to be a servant of the Liturgy, not its Master. The Instruction of the Roman Missal says: “the priest must remember that he is the servant of the sacred Liturgy and that he himself is not permitted, on his own initiative, to add, to remove, or to change anything in the celebration of Mass” (*General Instruction of the Roman Missal*, no. 24). What is given by the Universal Church is to be followed with care.

**The Pastoral Consultation, the Ongoing Formation, the Recollection, Chrism Mass:** This is a gentle reminder that we keep aside 7 April 2022 for these important events. We gather in the Centenary Memorial Hall of St Joseph Seminary at 9.00 a.m. for the first two events, and then we proceed to Holy Rosary Cathedral for the Recollection and Chrism Mass. No priest should miss these events, unless seriously impeded by some emergencies.

**The Pre-Synodal Celebration:** The coordinating committee of the Synod at the level of the Diocese has great responsibility of synthesizing the responses from all the Parishes and Institutions. As announced earlier, we shall have the Pre-Synodal celebration on 5 May 2022 at St Sebastian Church Hall at Bendur. The primary participants are the members of the College of Consultors, the Council of Priests and the Diocesan Pastoral Council. We shall discuss the text prepared by the coordinating committee, add our own observations, and thus learn a new way of being the Church. The result will be sent to the Regional Office as well as to the Central Coordinating Committee.

**Russia-Ukraine War:** Pope Francis expressed several times his concern towards warring nations and he invited us to consecrate Russia and Ukraine to the Immaculate Heart of Mary on the day

of Annunciation. The Bishops of the World have joined with the Supreme Pontiff and have prayed for peace through the intercession of the Queen of Peace. When there is a lot of loss of life and property, we as believers intensely pray that war may cease and that normalcy and understanding may be restored. Please encourage the families to pray the intercessory prayers after the family prayer. These have been already sent to you by Mangala Jyothi.

I wish you all a fruitful Holy Week and Blessed Easter. May the Risen Lord strengthen our faith.

## **DIOCESAN PHASE OF THE SYNOD 2021-2023**

The Diocesan Phase of the Synod was inaugurated in our Diocese on 17 October 2021 with the Solemn Eucharistic Celebration at the Rosario Cathedral presided over by Bishop Peter Paul Saldanha. Thenceforth a workshop on Synod was organized to all the priests, religious and the lay leaders on 21 October at Our Lady of Immaculate Conception Church Urwa. Questionnaires were formulated in order to discuss in the parishes and institutions. The responses and reflections have reached the Office of the Vicar General, and now we are in the process of synthesizing all the responses. A ten-page summary will be prepared. It will be

placed in the pre-synodal meeting, which will be held on Wednesday, 5 May 2022 at St Sebastian Church Hall, Bendur, Mangalore, participated by the members of the Council of Priests and members of the Diocesan Pastoral Council. The final summary will be sent to the Regional Office by the end of May. I thank all the parish priests, heads of the Institutions, Pastoral Commission secretaries for your active participation and cooperation in the Diocesan Synodal Process.

In recent days the Holy Father has repeatedly invited us to pray, asking God for the gift of peace for Ukraine, so that this “repugnant war” may come to an end. Together with Ukraine we would also like to recall all the other conflicts, which are unfortunately always numerous, in many countries of the world, a situation that Pope Francis has described as *a piecemeal third world war*. In the Celebration of the Passion of the Lord on Good Friday, the liturgy invites us to raise our petitions to God for the Church and for the whole world. In the Solemn Intercessions we will invoke the Lord for those in public office (prayer IX) *that our God and Lord may direct their minds and hearts according to his will for the true peace and freedom of all*, and for those in tribulation (prayer X) *that all may rejoice, because in their hour of need your mercy was at hand*. Let us now make these prayers our own for all our brothers and sisters who are experiencing the horror of war, particularly in Ukraine.

We would point out that “in a situation of grave public need, the Diocesan Bishop may permit or order the addition of a special intention” (*Missale Romanum, editio typica tertia*, p. 314, n. 13).

Let the celebration of Easter bring to all peoples the hope that comes solely from the resurrection of the Lord.
