### II. Commission for Catechetics – Information

1. **Priest Coordinators for Catechism and Liturgy at the Deanery Level:** Deans of the respective deaneries are requested to appoint a Priest Coordinator for Liturgy as well for Catechetical Ministry if you have not appointed him yet. Please complete the process by 30 July 2022. All the Coordinators will be having a meeting in the month of September/October.

The Priest Coordinator will take care of Liturgy and Catechetical Ministry at the Deanery level. He will organize:

- a) Deanery level catechism teachers' follow-up seminars;
- b) Collect report from the Parish Coordinators at the end of the year;
- c) Choir Members' or other required liturgical training at the deanery level in consultation with Mangala Jyothi team.

2. **Registration of Students' data online:** You (parish catechism coordinators) are requested to register students details online by visiting [www.mangalajyothi.com](http://www.mangalajyothi.com) / parish login / Sunday Catechism students' data. **It is mandatory. Kindly complete the process (from I Std. to X Std.) before 15th July 2022 if you have not completed yet.** After the 15<sup>th</sup> of July we will be issuing password protection facility to all the parishes so that your data will be protected.
3. **Sunday Catechism Textbooks:** Sunday catechism textbooks are available at Mangala Jyothi. Please complete the process of collection before 15 July 2022. Regarding books-related queries, contact [info@mangalajyothi.com](mailto:info@mangalajyothi.com) or 0824 2215747 from 09 a.m. to 05 p.m. on working days.
4. **Newly Selected Catechists' Training:** This year, we have trained 185 newly selected catechists. I thank all the parish priests and coordinators for taking a special interest in the catechetical apostolate.

### **III. Commission for Liturgy-Information:**

1. **Extraordinary Ministry:** We have trained 143 newly selected extraordinary ministers of Holy Communion this year. So the Parish Priests need to write to the Bishop requesting a faculty. Once you get the faculty, you need to install these new ministers during the Sunday Mass. The rite is given in the Handbook. Also, please enter the details of every extraordinary minister in the website under parish login/extraordinary ministers' data.
2. **Formation of Lectors' group:** As per the Pastoral Plan, you are requested to form a LECTORS group in your parish. Please organize a training programme for them in consultation with Mangala Jyothi. Some parishes have already initiated this process.

## **UPDATED GUIDELINES FOR CASES OF CLERICAL SEXUAL ABUSE OF MINORS**

Two years after the first edition, the Dicastery for the Doctrine of the Faith has published a second version of the “Vademecum on Certain Points of Procedure in Treating Cases of Sexual Abuse of Minors Committed by Clerics” on June 5, 2022. The work of revision has carefully considered, among other things, the various contributions from academic centres and studies in the field that have arrived in the last two years. Additionally, it notes, some points were clarified and improved after welcoming suggestions that came from numerous discussions with ecclesial organizations engaged in this area.

The updating of the first edition became necessary mainly as a result of the entering into force of Book VI of the Code of Canon Law and the “Norms Regarding Delicts Reserved to the Congregation for the Doctrine of the Faith” (7 December 2021), the motu proprio “Fidem servare” (14 February 2022) as well as the motu proprio “Competentias quasdam decernere” (15 February 2022), and finally, the Apostolic Constitution “Praedicate evangelium” (5 June 2022).

## THE SECOND WORLD DAY FOR GRANDPARENTS AND THE ELDERLY

On Sunday, July 24, 2022, the Second *World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly* will be celebrated throughout the universal Church. The theme chosen by the Holy Father for the occasion is “*In old age they will still bear fruit*” (Psalm 92:15) and intends to emphasize how grandparents and the elderly are a value and a gift both for society and for ecclesial communities.

Old age is not a time to give up and lower the sails, but a season of enduring fruitfulness: a new mission awaits us and bids us look to the future. “The special sensibility that those of us who are elderly have for the concerns, thoughts and the affections that make us human should once again become the vocation of many. It would be a sign of our love for the younger generations”. This would be our own contribution to the revolution of tenderness, a spiritual and non-violent revolution in which I encourage you, dear grandparents and elderly persons, to take an active role (Pope Francis, Message for the Second World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly, July 24, 2022)

Peter asks Jesus, referring to the younger, beloved disciple: “What about him?” Jesus’ response was, “What does it matter to you? You follow me.” The elderly should not be envious of the young who will outlive them (Pope Francis, General Audience, June 22, 2022).

Grandparents and the elderly are not leftovers from life, scraps to be discarded. They are precious pieces of bread left on the table of life that can still nourish us with a fragrance that we have lost, “the fragrance of mercy and of memory”. Let us not lose the memory preserved by the elderly, for we are children of that history, and without roots, we will wither. They protected us as we grew, and now it is up to us to protect their lives, to alleviate their difficulties, to attend to their needs and to ensure that they are helped in daily life and not feel alone (Pope Francis, Homily during the Mass on the World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly, July 25, 2021)
