BISHOP'S MESSAGE FOR DECEMBER 2021

Mystery of Incarnation: The transition from November to December even changes our mood, from one of gloom to joy, thanks to the birth of our Saviour: "For to us a child is born, to us a son is given" (Isa 9: 6). There may be hundreds of reasons why people could be sad and desolate, but the thought of Christmas cheers our hearts. The star of Bethlehem, the Crib, the little babe lying on the manger and Mother Mary and Saint Joseph rapt in contemplation, the ox and the donkey warming up the whole atmosphere, bring a twinkle in our eyes. "For while gentle silence enveloped all things, and night in its swift course was now half gone, your all-powerful word leaped from heaven, from the royal throne, into the midst of the land that was doomed" (Wis 18:14-15). As humanity is anxious of the things happening around us, the pandemic, the climatic change, and other hazards, the word of consolation is born for us, as bone of our bones and flesh of our flesh (cf. Gen 2:23), to be united with humanity once and for all, never to be separated. Let us welcome Jesus Saviour in our hearts, in our homes and neighbourhood.

Advent Season and Prayer Experience: As Advent is the time for waiting, a time of great expectations, as well as a memory of his first coming in the fragility of our flesh, a suitable prayer experience can enhance our spiritual desires. You are requested to jointly organize some prayer meetings during Advent with the Christians of other denominations to contemplate the mystery of the incarnation. Listening to the spiritual experiences of our brethren

of other denominations will do us good to nourish our own spiritual lives as our sharing will help them too.

Sauharda and Bandhutva Christmas: During December, we organize many Christmas gatherings with the brethren of other Christian denominations (Sauharda Christmas) and with the people of other faith traditions (Bandhutva Christmas). The heavenly child unites us all. In fact, it is God's plan to unite all things in Christ, things in heaven and things on earth (cf. Eph 1:10). Therefore, kindly join hands with the brethren from other denominations and other faith traditions so that we create a wonderful atmosphere of fraternity. The Son of God, by becoming human, has united himself with every human being (cf. GS 22). He helps us to discover our true worth and dignity. May this Christmas enable us to foster greater collaboration in all walks of life.

A New Time Table for the Synodal Process: The President of the Conference of Catholic Bishops of India, Archbishop Filipe Neri, has informed us that the General Secretariat has given more time for our synodal sharing at the local level and, therefore, the Diocesan Pre-Synodal celebration will be held accordingly, though initially, we had said that it would take place on January 12, 2022. Now, until January 15, 2022, we have time for dissemination of information, preparation to have consultations, choose questions, decide upon groups, select models, and give training to coordinators.

From January 15 - March 2022: Consultation phase, preparing reports. By March 30, all the consultation reports are to be submitted to the diocesan contact Persons. From April to May 15, 2022: All dioceses will prepare a "Working Document" in preparation for the Diocesan Synod and will conduct the Diocesan Synod. By May 31, 2022: The 10-page diocesan summary should reach the Regional Deputy Secretaries (RDs). By June 20, 2022: the RDs will prepare a 10 page "consolidated Report" from Diocesan summaries, which should be sent to the Central Coordinating Team.

Word of Gratitude: The sudden demise of Rev. Fr Valerian Lewis has really shaken us. We lost two young priests within a span of one month. Despite the pain, we have one wonderful lesson to ponder over. The cooperation of our people was tremendous. I thank all those who helped in organizing the funeral service and all the other connected activities at Katipalla Parish. I gratefully acknowledge the services of the Dean, Priests of Mother Teresa Deanery, the Parish Pastoral Council members of the Katipalla Parish and everyone who has given a helping hand.

Therefore, all the parishes and institutions will submit their synthesis by 30 March 2022 to the Vicar General's Office at the Bishop's House. Kindly make use of this extra time for more interactions to facilitate the participation of a maximum number of people. We shall have the Pre-Synodal consultation in May, after which the diocesan synthesis will be submitted to the Regional Secretary before the end of May 2022.

II. Commission for Liturgy:

1. Christmas Novena and Advent Wreath:

Christmas is an important feast for all of us. Many Dioceses in the world pray Novena for Christmas. Last year we started Novena Prayers for Christmas in our diocese. The Novena will begin from 16 December 2021. I request all the Parish Priests to begin these Novena Prayers in your parish and kindly motivate/inform your Parishioners to have this devotion in their families. Also, there is a custom of Blessing of the Advent wreath on the First Sunday of Advent. The rite of Blessing is included in the Novena Book. The Books are available at our Book Stall.

2. Liturgical guidelines during Advent season:

- (a) Kindly refer to instructions given in the Ordo during the Advent season. Please maintain the spirit of Advent season during the liturgical celebrations. An adequate catechesis on the importance of the season must be given to the faithful.
- (b) During all the Sundays of the Advent Ritual Masses are not permitted, so also on Saturdays after 4 p.m. In the case of Weddings, Mass of the Sunday and all the rubrics of the proper Sunday must be used (No Gloria; purple colour vestments and so on).

3. Revised Gospel Acclamation - Alleluia: (Reminder note) The Congregation of the Divine Worship and Discipline of the Sacraments (CDWDS) desires that we retain ALLELUIA in our liturgy. Therefore, hereafter we shall sing only ALLELUIA and avoid Alle, Allelu, Jai Jai and Sorvesporak Jai Jai. I request the Parish Priests to instruct the choir / those who lead singing in the parish, and follow the direction. Mangala Jyothi has prepared the Audio for Alleluias for every liturgical season and celebration of the sacraments. They are available on the Diocesan Youtube channel. The musical notation is now available at our stall.

4. Extraordinary Ministers - Certificate and Faculty renewal: (Reminder)

The handbook for extraordinary ministers of Holy Communion is now available both in Konkani and English. It includes many new guidelines. The persons selected for the ministry of Extraordinary ministers must be 40 years old (The Bishop of the Diocese may permit Seminarians and Religious Women of another age). However, they may render their ministry up to the age of 65 and not 70.

Please maintain a separate file or register for extraordinary ministry. Some ministers do not have certificates. Some Parish Priests are asking Religious Sisters to distribute communion who do not have training and certificates, which is not permitted. Some parishes have not renewed the faculty. Considering all these issues, we have started a training programme for both - new and existing extraordinary ministers at the deanery or parish level from January 2021. I request Rev. Deans and Parish Priests to look into the matter and organise training programmes and recollections. We will be issuing new certificates for those who do not have them. Please keep one photocopy of the certificate in the parish file. Normally, the Bishop gives the mandate for 3 years, which is to be renewed by the Parish Priest if their services are needed further.

Kindly organise recollection for the Extraordinary ministers during advent season at the deanery level.

5. Training for Lectors and Choir members: We have already started training the choir members as well as Lectors in some parishes. It is one of the objectives of the new pastoral plan of the diocese. Please organise training programmes for Lectors and choir members in your parish or at the deanery level. It is better to have a trained Lectors group in a parish.

Some choirmasters or leaders are selecting new hymns for the feasts/weddings/Jubilee, which are not approved and are not liturgical and are not permitted to use during the liturgy. I request the Parish Priest/Asst to direct the choirmasters in this aspect. Please do not leave everything to the choirmaster to decide upon liturgical matters. For any assistance, please feel free to contact Mangala Jyothi. The handbook for Lectors as well as choir members is available at Mangala Jyothi.

III. Commission for Catechetics

1. Sunday and School Catechism/VE Classes:

Offline classes are mandatory with all the COVID precautions. Therefore, hereafter there will not be regular online classes. However, we will be broadcasting one class per month for the additional reference of all the students.

Regarding School Catechism and Value Education, a separate circular is sent to heads of the schools. It is also available on our website www.mangalajyothi.com

Mangala Jyothi website and App is in the process of revision. So it will be released soon.

COMMISSION FOR BIBLE - MANGALA JYOTHI

1. Short Video reflection on the Daily Gospel:

Beginning from 28th November 2021, we will be sharing in the social media platform a two-minute video reflection titled, ಶುಭ್ವತ್ತಮಾನ್-ದಿಸಾಚ್ಯೆ ಸುವಾರ್ತೆಚೆರ್ ದೋನ್ ಮಿನುಟಾಂಚೆಂ ಪ್ರೇರಣ್. I request you to share it with the people of the parish with the help of the biblical commission members of the parish.

2. Scripture Reading at the Parish Level:

"While it [God's word] is a word addressed to each of us personally, it is also a word which builds community, which builds the Church. Consequently, the sacred text must always be approached in the communion of the Church. In effect, 'a communal reading of Scripture is extremely important, because the living subject in the sacred Scriptures is the People of God, it is the Church..." (Verbum Domini, 86).

In this regard, I request you to organize the Bible reading sessions in the parish. Each book of the Bible has its own author, theology and significance. Hence, it is recommended that we dedicate three hours, once in three months, for the communal reading of the Bible, beginning with one Gospel at a time. Therefore, I suggest the following programme for the communal reading of the Bible: ചೈಬರ್ ವಾಚ್ಯಾಂ-ಬೈಬರ್ ವಾಂಚ್ಯಾಂ. Let's read the Bible - Let's live the Bible.

We can follow a simple model for reading. In December 2021 and January 2022, we take up the Gospel of Matthew.

- a) People gather in the church or a hall.
- b) We may begin with a suitable hymn as the copy of the Bible is brought in procession and garlanded.
- c) The priest or the leader reads out a short introduction on the book of Matthew.
- d) The entire Gospel is read out clearly (if there are sufficient readers, one person reads one chapter).
- e) At the end, if there is time, people may be given an opportunity to announce loudly a verse or a phrase or a word-which touched them most while reading.
- f) A short prayer, Our Father and hymn.

3. Bible Classes Series - 1

From the 2nd week of January 2022, we will be holding regular bible classes at Mangala Jyothi, Pastoral Centre, Shanthi Kiran, Bajjodi. To begin with, on five Saturdays, from 3.00 p.m. to 6 p.m., on January 8, 15, 22, 29, and February 5 we will be holding a bible course on the **Gospel of Matthew in Konkani**. This will help us to study the Gospel more profoundly. The course will be for the priests, religious and the laity. Therefore, I request you to encourage people to join the course.

4. Online Bible Classes:

From June 2022, we begin Online Bible Classes for the laity with contact programmes in Konkani. Details will be made known later.

5. Konkani Bible / NT Revision: The New Testament in Konkani is in the process of revision. The first draft is completed. If you come across any printing or translation errors in the current edition (both OT & NT) please inform us.

REPORT OF KARNATAKA REGION "YOUNG CLERGY MEET 2021"

November 16-19, 2021, Sannidhi, Shimoga

Karnataka Regional "Young Clergy Meet - 2021" was organized by Regional Commission for Vocation and Formation, Priests and Religious in Sannidi, Pastoral Centre, Shimoga from 16th to 18th, November 2021. The young priests of Karnataka region ordained from 2011 to 2021 attended this three day ongoing formation. Around 131 young priests from Latin, Syro-Malabar and Syro-Malankara dioceses of Karnataka took part in it. From the Diocese of Mangalore, thirty nine priests participated in the programme.

DAY 1 (Tuesday, 16th November 2021): The inaugural session of Young Clergy Meet-2021 began with a prayer service. Bishop Peter Paul Saldanha delivered the keynote address on "The Vision of Pope Francis of a Missionary Church", which he set the tone for the event. In his address he stressed upon the missionary role of the Church.

Talk 1 – "A Synodal Church: Communion, Participation & Mission" - Bp Peter Paul Saldanha: Bishop Peter Paul Saldanha explained the terms "synod" and 'synodality'. He said that the attitude of the Synodal process is to avoid clericalism and to listen to the people of God like God listens. The journey along with the people is the need of the hour which will help us to understand the signs of times and spaces.

Talk 2 – "Challenges of Young Priests" – Bp Francis Serrao: Bishop Francis Serrao, SJ, began the address quoting Richard Wurham, 'Saints are not enough.' World needs saints, because the world has plenty of politicians, scientists, missionaries and so on and so forth. But saints are not enough. He categorized priests as Excellent, Problematic and Mediocre and that the number of the latter is on the rise. The Bishop enumerated Ten challenges of priests today. He stressed upon the aspect of mediocrity which makes the priests compromise on gospel values.

Holy Mass: Bishop Peter Paul Saldanha in his homily elucidated the emptiness of mind and emptiness of the heart. The desire of Zacchaeus made him a transformed man because the emptiness of his heart was fulfilled when he encountered Jesus.

Sharing of Joys and Sorows and Mission during Covid-19 Pandemic: After evening supper, the young clergy shared their personal experiences of joys and sorrows, especially about their mission experiences during Covid-19. The priests shared their personal experiences, such as, administering communion to the sick to the COVID positive patients; experience of Covid-19 burials in the city of Bangalore, where this priest was part of arranging more than 3000 burials in both the waves of the pandemic; 'Share & Care' – the mission of providing food for the needy during the pandemic; the challenges of managing the educational institutions during the pandemic; experience of coordinating the covid-19 burials through the covid-19 helpline. The necessity of being with the people was essential during the pandemic and was pivotal and satisfying ministry.

DAY 2 (Wednesday 17th, November 2021): The second day of the Young Clergy Meet 2021, began with Morning Prayer and the Holy Eucharist. Most Rev. Dr Francis Serrao, in his homily, enlightened about the Synod and Synod logo. Synod means journeying together with all. The logo of the Synod has all kinds of people rich and poor, sick and healthy, young and old, religious men and women. The Pope gets this idea from Franciscan spirituality of the crib. Everybody has a place in the crib. All kinds of people, animals, stars, Dry land, green land. He insisted that our ordination doesn't make us superiors but servants.

Talk - 3 "Amendments to the Penal Laws of the Church-Book VI of the Canon Law" - Rev. Dr Victor George D'Souza: The third talk began with a hymn "Shepherd me oh Lord" which was played with the help of Power Point. Fr Victor said that the VI book is used less, because it is quite not forceful and the penal sanctions were left to the discretion of the bishops. Therefore this book is revised from the time of the papacy of Pope Benedict XVI and Pope Francis has completed it and issued the degree, "Pascite Gregem Dei" for its implementation on 8 December 2021. He also presented certain penalty for some specific offenses and sins in the Church. The uniqueness of this revised code is that it also be implemented on the laity if found guilty of offenses. After the session there was time for dialogue.

Talk - 4 "Human Resource Management in the Parish"-Rev. Fr Duming Dias: Rev. Fr Duming Dias said, managing is "the ability of getting the things done by identifying the individuals." He gave the example of Jesus, because he was a human resources management professional. He selected those who would be his core team. He used a method of orientation to evangelize. Golden rules, laws of mercy, beatitudes was the unique concept in Jesus's teaching.

Talk - 5 "Conference of Diocesan Priests in India"-Rev. Fr Richard Britto: Rev. Fr Richard Britto spoke of the importance and need of CDPI. Canon 278 §1 states, "Secular clerics have the right to associate with others to

pursue purposes in keeping with the clerical state.§2. Secular clerics are to hold in esteem especially those associations which, having statutes recognized by competent authority, foster their holiness in the exercise of the ministry through a suitable and properly approved rule of life and through fraternal assistance and which promote the unity of clerics among themselves and with their own bishop." He explained membership, duties, structure, office bearers, terms, responsibility of CDPI. Lots of doubts and quarries were raised by the priests.

Adoration and Cultural Evening: Young clergy took active part in Adoration and evening prayer at 7 p.m. After the supper cultural event was organized. Priests according to their diocese presented ten creative programmes.

DAY 3 (Thursday 18th, November 2021): The third day of the ongoing formation of the young clergy began with Morning Prayer and the Holy Eucharist. Very Rev. Felix Noronha, Vicar General of Shimoga was the main celebrant.

Talk - 6 Role of Laity in the Church: Prof. William D'Souza, JCI International Trainer, Principal of Hoysala College of Management, Shimoga and Mrs. Clara Fernandes, Belgaum chaired a sharing and panel discussion on "the role of the Church in promoting Lay leadership." Prof. D'Souza quoted St John Paul II, "the third millennium is of the Laity." He mentioned a few problems in developing lay leadership in the churches and highlighted certain challenges of developing leadership in the Church. He said that there is steady decline of young and dedicated clergy, religious and lay faithful. He urged the young clergy to motivate youth in parishes to take up leadership in the political, government administration and judiciary system by encouraging them to write competitive exams.

Mrs Clara Fernandes, secretary of Commission for Laity, Diocese of Belgaum speaking on Leadership in the Church said that the Scripture and Canon Law give clear foundation for the creation of leaders. Clericalism is very dominant which needs to be transformed into active participation of Lay faithful.

She presented the mind of Pope Francis on Lay leadership. She gave a few suggestions to foster the lay leadership. The question and answer session was followed at the end.

General Evaluation: Fr Richard Britto conducted a fruitful evaluation session and gathered all the enriching experiences from priests. Priests shared their positive feelings and appreciations. They also expressed a few suggestions to make this gathering better in future.

Appreciations: The programme is very useful in upgrading and grow in communion with other priests; it unites, encourages and solves many problems and difficulties of young clergy; the venue and planned programme were very suitable; food, accommodation and facilities were good; ambience was excellent for the training programme; it provided an opportunity to meet batchmates; all the talks and topics were well arranged and presented.

Suggestions: All can be encouraged to attend it, even Bishops can make it mandatory for all young clergy in each diocese; the days can be extend to four, the final day could be reserved for an outing; penitential service could be held during the programme; group discussions would make the gathering more effective; various other topics may have to be considered; more opportunities for ice breaking could be arranged; dates that take into account convenience of all, public holidays so as to facilitate the participation of priests working in the institutions; provide a forum to interact with batch mates.
