BISHOP'S MESSAGE FOR JULY 2019

A couple of extraordinary events that call for holiness of life are at our doorstep: one is the Conclusion of the Diocesan Phase of the Inquiry of the Cause of Beatification and Canonization of the Servant of God Raymond Francis Camillus Mascarenhas and another is the Annual Retreat of the Second Batch. If the first one points at the life of holiness of one of our diocesan priests, the other provides the opportunity given for our own sanctification. The first one holds before our eyes the example of one of our brethren and the second one helps us to strive for holiness at all times and in all circumstances. The first is the first of its kind in the history of the Diocese of Mangalore, the second one is also unique, though a regular event. In the closing of the process of Inquiry, one stage of arduous work comes to an end, only to begin the Roman phase where the Postulator with the guidance of the Relator has to work hard to put together the data in order to show that the Servant of God lived heroically the theological and cardinal virtues in great humility. The theologians and cardinals will then scrutinize the whole work and recommend to the Pope for his approval.

What is the hallmark of holiness? In his Apostolic Letter on holiness, Gaudete et Exsultate, Pope Francis speaks of holiness as happiness. Indeed, the holy people are happy people: "The word 'happy' or 'blessed'... becomes a synonym for 'holy'. It expresses the fact that those faithful to God and his word, by their self-giving, gain true happiness" (GE 64). Prayer is the instrument that makes us truly happy as it connects us with the source of joy and with the reality around us. Prayer enlarges our heart to contain God himself. In Spe Salvi, Pope Benedict citing Augustine says about God's way of delaying to concur with our requests; it is to create in us greater desire. "Man was created for greatness—for God himself; he was created to be filled by God. But his heart is too small for the greatness to which it is destined. It must be stretched. "By delaying [his gift], God strengthens our desire; through desire he enlarges our soul and by expanding it he increases its capacity [for receiving him]" (SS 33).

The Russian pilgrim who prayed constantly reminds us how the unceasing prayer brings along with it the waves of joy. Such prayer did not separate him from what was happening all around him. He says: "Everybody was kind to me; it was as though everyone loved me... Not only did I feel [happiness and consolation] in my own soul, but the whole outside world also seemed to me full of charm and delight" (GE 152). The spirit within us rejoices when it is connected with the Eternal lifegiving Spirit. Prayerful people, who recognize God in others or rather, consider the God of their adoration as also the God of their neighbour, love unconditionally and experience the love of God and others.

We are reminded that holiness could be acquired by each one of us as all have the same call. In holiness there isn't a hierarchy, as if to say some are called to greater holiness than others. No. Pope Francis insists that silent conversation with God is required for all to be holy and "this is true not only for a privileged few, but for all of us, for 'we all have need of this silence, filled with the presence of him who is adored'. Trust-filled prayer is a response of a heart open to encountering God

face to face, where all is peaceful and the quiet voice of the Lord can be heard in the midst of silence" (GE 149).

The Lord calls each one in his or her own way to be holy and many times such holiness may not be recognized at all. For God's life is communicated "to some in one way and to others in another" (GE 11), and each one is called to reflect one ray of light coming from the Eternal Sun. It is paying attention to the little details of love with utmost care as Jesus and Mary did. Saint John of the Cross exhorts us: "Endeavour to remain always in the presence of God, either real, imaginative, or unitive, insofar as is permitted by your works" (GE 148).

Those of us who have not done the **annual retreat** will be having an occasion for experiencing holiness through prayer and contemplation from 21 to 26 July, at the Pastoral Institute. Every priest is obliged to do the annual retreat and seek holiness. Rev. Fr Juventius Andrade, a Redemptorist priest who preached to the December batch would be coming again. As I thank him for his service, I encourage all the priests who have not done their annual retreat in the last batch to enrol their names unfailingly.

In this month, **July 16** is unique for many reasons: that day we celebrate the feast of **Our Lady of Mount Carmel**; that day Mother Mary appeared for the last time to Bernadette Soubirous at Lourdes in 1854; and the Congregation of the Sisters of the Little Flower of Bethany was founded in the year 1921 on 16 July by the Servant of God trusting in the providence of God and intercession of Mother Mary. May this day also be for us a day charged with the love of God for each one us.

On **July 17**, as we will be concluding the whole process of identifying the virtues lived by the Servant of God, both the Diocese of Mangalore and the Bethany Congregation are grateful to him for his great contribution towards the holiness of the people of God in this part of the world. He had to swim against the current to provide good education to girls and come to aid of the poorer classes. He is an inspiration for priests, religious and the laity. Let us pray that the Lord grant us a saint from our own brethren to inspire and intercede for us.

A warm welcome to all the priests in our diocese to participate in this event.

RENEWAL OF FACULTY AND MANDATE

We request Parish Priests to look into the list of Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion (EMHC) who are ministering in the Parish. All EMHC after having participated in the liturgical formation programme and obtained a certification from the DBCLC (Mangala Jyothi) should receive the faculty from the Bishop in order to carry out this extraordinary ministry. Those who have already received the faculty can minister until the time specified in the faculty sheet. If the term of ministry has lapsed, the Parish Priest should request the Bishop to renew the term of ministry of these EMHC. Otherwise, with the expiration of the faculty, they cease to be EMHC.

In the same manner, Parish Priests are requested to check the list of Gurkars (ward leaders). The manner of election, the approval or confirmation of the election by the Bishop and the renewal of their term should be done according to the Constitutions. During the Pastoral Visit, it has come to our notice that in some parishes the maintenance and updating the list with necessary data, such as date of birth, election and confirmation, renewal of term etc has not been given adequate attention. Parish Priests are requested to carry out their responsibility with due diligence.

IN PREPARATION FOR OCTOBER: EXTRAORDINARY MISSIONARY MONTH

For a hundred years the Church has marked October as Mission Month. This year it takes on even greater significance as Pope Francis has designated October 2019 as an Extraordinary Missionary Month (EMM) to celebrate the 100th anniversary Pope Benedict XV's Apostolic Letter *Maximum Illud* which emphasized the importance of mission. The Papal Letter *Maximum Illud* takes its title from the opening words of the original Latin text, meaning "that momentous". Pope Benedict begins by recalling "that momentous and holy charge" found in Mark 16:15: "Go into the whole world and preach the gospel to all creation." Benedict wrote the apostolic letter because "there still remain in the world immense multitudes of people who dwell in darkness and in the shadow of death" (no. 6).

The Church is essentially missionary in character. It does not engage in mission for one Sunday, or even one month, out of the year. Christ did not found his Church so we could have mission calendars, mission boxes, auctions, mission-fancy fetes, and housie-housie games for mission collections. He commissioned his first followers to "Go into the whole world and pro-claim the gospel to every creature" (Mk 16:15). Mission was their job, and it is our job too.

This year, the theme of the Mission's Extraordinary Month is "Baptized and Sent: Christ's Church on Mission in the World" to remind us that each of us is called to mission by our baptism. The aim of the EMM is to encourage Catholics into a deeper relationship with Jesus through prayer; to look to and learn from the actions and sacrifices made by our saints, martyrs, and living missionaries; to rediscover and renew our understanding of overseas mission (ad gentes); to financially support mission.

Pope Francis has proposed four focus areas in celebra-tion of the Extraordinary Month of Mission.

1. A personal encounter with Jesus Christ living in his Church: in the Eucharist, in the Word of God.

- **2. Testimony:** missionary saints, martyrs, and confessors of the faith as an expression of the Church.
- **3. Missionary formation:** biblical, catechetical, spiri-tual, and theological.

4. Missionary charity.

We are always focused on mission and an outreach to the people of the world who have not yet heard the Good News. I invite the clergy, the religious and the laity of the Diocese of Mangalore to renew the missionary zeal in line with the desire of Pope Francis. This topic will be discussed in the up-coming meeting of the Council of Priests.

Workshop on Psychological First Aid (PFA) to Teachers

Dear Correspondents/ Heads of Institutions,

We have begun a new school year and doing the noble duty of guiding our students to be responsible human beings. As we deal with our students we may find it hard to guide them especially in psychological and emotional spheres. All of us belong to 'x' or 'y' generations (born before 2000) and we are dealing with students belonging to 'z' generation (born between 2000-2017). At times, our guidance, inputs and corrections doesn't help them and may have adverse effects on them. The educational policies too discourage the traditional forms of guidance and corrections. We notice generational differences, behavioural problems, psychological and emotional difficulties in our students. We have hard times to understand them, which makes difficult to guide them and in turn create a lot of stress in us. We hope that certain amount of assistance may enable our teachers and animators to equip them with skills to identify, assess and guide in psychological needs and developmental hazards of our children. So we are organizing two level workshop on Psychological First Aid during this academic year.

As you know, we had conducted workshop 3 years back and we received a very positive response from the teachers and educational institutions. They also requested us to conduct such workshops/seminars every year. We couldn't conduct it in the last two years. This year we have planned to conduct the workshop through professionally qualified and practically experienced resource team. As the workshop is very useful and professional we need your cooperation in sending the teachers for both the levels of workshop.

The workshop will be held in two levels of two days each at the week-ends. The workshop will shed light on psychology, Management of classroom behavioural problems, counseling skills, and soft skills to deal with our children. The workshop will be for teachers of Higher Primary and High schools.
