BISHOP'S MESSAGE FOR JUNE 2019

The month of June is dedicated to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. The Church celebrates the Solemnity of the Sacred Heart of Jesus on the Friday following the second Sunday after Pentecost. It is also the month that celebrates the Immaculate Heart of Mary. As these feast days are in this month, June is therefore considered as a month of love. God is love, and the Sacred Heart of Jesus manifests the love of God for us. The feast of the Body and Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi) which we celebrate in this month is another expression of God's love: "There is no greater love than to lay down one's life for one's friends" (Jn 15:13).

The devotion to the **Sacred Heart of Jesus** is one of the most widely practiced and well-known devotions, taking Jesus' physical heart as the representation of his divine love for humanity. The devotion especially emphasizes the love, compassion, and long-suffering of the heart of Christ towards humanity. From the time of John the Evangelist and Paul, there has always been in the Church something like devotion to the love of God; nevertheless, the devotion remained an individual, or at least a private devotion until 1670. It was in that year that the first feast of the Sacred Heart was celebrated in Rennes, France, through the efforts of Fr. Jean Eudes (1602-1680).

From France, the devotion spread, but the visions of St. Margaret Mary Alacoque in 1675 helped the devotion to become universal. We know that many devotional exercises are connected with the Sacred Heart of Jesus: Personal Consecration, Family Consecration, Litany of the Sacred Heart of Jesus, Act of Reparation to the Sacred Heart of Jesus, The First Fridays, Enthronement of the Sacred Heart, and Twelve Promises of Jesus to St. Margaret Mary.

In biblical language, 'heart' indicates the centre of the person where his sentiments and intentions dwell. In the Heart of the Redeemer, we adore God's love for humanity, his will for universal salvation, his infinite mercy. The call which comes from

this feast day is first of all a call to Eucharistic Adoration. To spend time in the Presence of the Eucharistic Lord, to adore Him, is the best expression of devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus Who said to St Margaret Mary: ‘Behold the Heart which so loved mankind and is so little loved in return!’ For many years, Catholics faithfully practised this nine first Fridays devotion, but more recently there seems little effort in this regard.

Schools begin their academic year in June. The mission of Catholic schools is not just to provide a high standard of academic learning for our students but also to help develop a Christ-centred faith relationship with Jesus Christ. Pastoral care reflects the sacredness of each individual, when individuals are encouraged to know, love and respect themselves as children of God and when a culture of excellence is fastened in the heart of the Gospel. We need to remind ourselves that “our institutions do not pursue the narrow goal of academic prestige, with a strong focus on marks and medals, but instead aim to foster human values and spiritual maturity among the students and staff. In fact, if a Catholic institution, excellent as an academic institution, does not find it possible to implement the essential characteristics of our Christian values and is not committed to our Mission, we would consider it a radical failure on our part.” (CBCI All India Catholic Education Policy 2007).

Let us adhere to All India Catholic Education Policy according to which all Catholics are admitted to our schools, on their essential merit that they are *Catholics*. “No Catholic child, Dalit/Tribal or otherwise, should be deprived of quality education because of a lack of means. [...] Those disadvantaged, socially, physically or intellectually, will be specially assisted so that they can be integrated into the educational system. We make this preferential option, even if in this process academic results suffer. All Catholic schools whether run by dioceses, the religious, corporate bodies or individuals, are expected to participate in this project”.

We celebrate the **Laity Sunday** on 30th June 2019. We reflect on the witness of St Thomas More, the heavenly patron

of Lay faithful, who as a lay person had the courage to be faithful to the Gospel. The Laity Sunday brings us a splendid opportunity to reflect on the vocation and role of Laity. Pope Francis has expressed it powerfully in his address to the Laity Council: “We are in need of well-formed laypeople, animated by a pure and fresh faith, whose life has been touched by a personal and merciful encounter with the love of Jesus Christ. We are in need of laypeople who risk, who soil their hands, who are not afraid of erring, who go forward. We are in need of laypeople with vision of the future, not closed in the little things of life. And I have said it to young people: we are in need of laypeople with the taste of experience of life, who dare to dream”

In our diocese **Sunday Catechism** Year starts from June. Kindly follow the instructions given by DBCLC, which has also given us adequate material that can be used for the inauguration of catechism year. Every Parish Priest should take personal initiative to plan the classes along with catechetical teachers, schedule meetings, and interact with students and provide inspiration and encouragement. Sunday Catechism is not limited to just teaching the prescribed text, rather it is a process of moulding the students into mature disciples of Jesus. Hence in addition to classes, other faith formation activities should have a place in the annual programme: regular prayers, confession, spiritual counselling, class wise adoration with their teacher, student retreat, outreach programmes etc are right steps taken in this direction.

The season of **priest transfers and assignments** is getting over. Transfer time is a season of some anxiety as one hears what Abram heard from God: “get up and go to the land I will show you.” (Gen 12:1). A shift in location, residence or assignment produces some discomfort, pain, and uncertainty. For us who have given ourselves totally to the Lord’s service without any conditions, it is part of life. But obedience prompts us to accept the order with trust and brings in blessings as it happened in the case of Abram: “I will make of you a great nation, and I will bless you, and make your name great, so that you will be a

blessing” (Gen.12:2). God’s blessing is not limited to one’s own benefit. Its purpose is to enable his people to be a blessing to others.

Transfer time is the ideal moment to bring to your kind attention what I preached on May 2, 2019 at the Mass of Ordination of Priests of our diocese. Some priests have told me that it was ‘an inspiring homily’ and some others ‘a touching / touchy homily’! Bishop Francis Serrao SJ of Shimoga has also expressed similar issue in his diocesan bulletin: “Avoid all unnecessary tensions and misunderstandings among us, we need to transcend every kind of nostalgic attachment to our earlier place and position, and avoid going to the former place unnecessarily and too often, much less, interfering in the internal matters of that place. Any negative criticism of our predecessors and successors is highly damaging to the unity of Presbyterium. If you find something seriously amiss anywhere kindly bring it to my notice but do not gossip about it. Always be positive wherever you go. Get to know the people. Let them know that you care. Visit families, Befriend the youth. Be a real father to all.”

Since 2002, on the occasion of the Solemnity of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus, we celebrate the World Day of **Prayer for the Sanctification of Priests**. I thank the Lord for the priests serving in this diocese and for their fidelity to the love of Christ. The invitation of the Lord to “remain in his love” (cf. Jn. 15:9) is valid for all the baptised, but on the feast of the Sacred Heart of Jesus, it resounds with a new power in us, his priests. St John Marie Vianney said, “the priesthood is the love of the heart of Jesus”. We must never forget that from this heart sprang the gift of the priestly ministry. Let us spend more time in the presence of the Eucharistic Lord during the month of June and reflect on the wonderful love of Christ for each and every one of us.

THE 53RD WORLD COMMUNICATIONS DAY

On Sunday June 2, 2019

World Communications Day, the only worldwide celebration called for by the Second Vatican Council (*Inter Mirifica*, 1963), is celebrated in most countries, on the basis of the recommendation of the bishops of the world, on the Sunday before Pentecost.

On 24 January 2019, the liturgical memorial of Saint Francis de Sales, patron saint of writers and journalists, the Holy See released the Holy Father's Message for the 53rd World Communications Day. The message is entitled "We are members of one another (Eph 4:25): From social network communities to the human community".

In his Message, Pope Francis emphasizes the importance of the word community: "A community is that much stronger if it is cohesive and supportive, if it is animated by feelings of trust, and pursues common objectives. The community as a network of solidarity requires mutual listening and dialogue, based on the responsible use of language."

To foster missionary zeal in the children, and to prepare them to be the missionaries, it is decided in the Commission for Proclamation and Evangelization that we give mission Sunday boxes to the children of our parish. 1. This number will be the Permanent official number of the Parish/Institution.
2. You will use this number for any public utility services for the Parish/Institution like, Telephone, Bank, Income tax returns, GST Returns, TDS, Gas etc. which are in the name of the parish/Institution.
3. All these numbers are grouped under CUG (Closed User Group). Calls to any numbers within this group are free. But you need to keep minimum balance of Rs 60/-
4. If the balance goes below Rs 60/- that number will be opted out of the group. Then you need to Recharge to keep the minimum balance and inform the procurator to add your number back to the group.
5. The existing BSNL Numbers can be added to this group to avail free call facility. If you want to add your personal BSNL number to this group, please send me your number by 20th June 2019.
6. The First recharge and SIM charges are paid by the Diocese.
7. The validity of this SIM is one year. You need to re charge by 31st March 2020 to continue the validity.
8. You can check the minimum balance and validity by dialling *123#.
9. You need to keep this number active through a mobile Phone. You can buy a Mobile phone for the Parish, preferably a smart phone. This will enable to use WhatsApp services.
10. If you want to use the Internet in this SIM, you have to recharge it with data pack.

STS PETER AND PAUL: TWO SAINTS BUT ONE MISSION

Peter's actual name was "Simon," and Paul's actual name was "Saul." They came into their second names, by which Christians commonly refer to them today, after they began following Jesus.

Their ancient cities are still standing. Peter was from Galilee, in modern-day Israel. Paul was from Tarsus, in modern-day Turkey. Their trades involved hard work. Peter was a fisherman by trade, while Paul was a tentmaker.

Their citizenship is actually one thing that makes them drastically different. Peter did not have Roman citizenship, while Paul did. As regards literacy, Peter hardly had any education, while Paul was highly educated, brought up at the feet of Gamaliel (Acts 22:3), and an extensive writer (having given us thirteen of the twenty-seven books of the New Testament). Saint Peter wrote only two epistles which consisted of 8 chapters.

Saint Peter was simple in his writings. Saint Peter said about saint Paul's epistles that some of the things "in all of his letters are hard to understand, and those who are ignorant and unstable have twisted his letters to mean something quite different, just as they do with other parts of Scripture. And this will result in their destruction" (2 Peter 3:16).

If we take into account ministerial timing, Peter – along with his brother, Andrew, was the first of Jesus' twelve original disciples to follow him. However, Paul did not come to follow Jesus until well after Jesus' earthly ministry had already concluded. Paul was not among the twelve, and not even among the seventy apostles, but the Lord chose him lastly, after the resurrection and years after the choice of Matthias. As regards role in the Church, Peter was the first pope (see Matthew 16:18), while Paul never served as pope.

Peter was not a particularly gifted speaker, and it was not until after Pentecost that he became a more prominent orator (see Acts 2:14-41). In linguistic matters, Peter at least spoke Aramaic, while Paul spoke various languages, including Greek and Hebrew.

The apostle Peter began his ministry while he was old-aged. Perhaps he was the oldest of all the apostles. Therefore they venerated his old age. But saint Paul was younger than saint Peter in age. So whether young or old, the Lord employs everyone for His work.

Peter and Paul's conversions were very different, but very well known. Peter was fishing at the time, while Paul was on his way to Damascus to continue persecuting Christians. Peter began his life with the Lord Christ with love, confidence, and faith. But on the contrary, Paul began by enmity, as a persecutor of the Church and of everyone who followed Christ, so that the Lord, when He met him on the road to Damascus, began his conversation with him by reprimanding him saying: "Saul, Saul, why are you persecuting Me?" (Acts 9:4).

St Peter was the Apostle to the Jews whereas St Paul was an Apostle to the Gentiles. In the words of St Paul: "For the same God who worked through Peter as the apostle to the Jews also worked through me as the apostle to the Gentiles" (Gal. 2:8). Each of us has a specific role to play while we work for Christ.

Peter and Paul had both been great sinners. Peter had denied Jesus not just once (as did Judas Iscariot, who unfortunately entered into despair rather than repenting), nor twice, but three times. Paul had been a fierce persecutor of Christians, consenting to the martyrdom of many. Despite their many differences, Peter and Paul both repented and truly followed the Lord, allowing their hearts to be converted to his will for the remainder of their lives, never denying him again. They served the Lord faithfully for decades after Jesus respectively called each of them to follow him, collaborating with other Apostles as they served the early Church.

They ultimately gave their lives for the Lord by being martyred in Rome around AD 64 under the harsh persecutions by the Emperor Nero. (Peter was notoriously crucified upside down, and Paul was beheaded.) They went to their deaths in accord with Jesus' sobering words: "If anyone wishes to come after me, he must deny himself and take up his cross daily and follow me" (Luke 9:23). ■
