## **BISHOP'S MESSAGE FOR MAY 2023**

**Marian Month:** This month, specially dedicated for devotion towards Mother Mary, challenges us to imitate the virtues of the Mother of God. The Church in *Lumen Gentium* reminds us: "Let the faithful remember moreover that true devotion consists neither in sterile or transitory affection, nor in a certain vain credulity, but proceeds from true faith, by which we are led to know the excellence of the Mother of God, and we are moved to a filial love toward our mother and to the imitation of her virtues" (n. 67). True love urges us to imitate her virtues with filial love, such as faith, fidelity to the word given to the Lord and readiness to do God's will, always considering herself as the "handmaid" of the Lord. Therefore, while promoting the devotion of praying Angelus and Rosary in the families and institutions, let us also help our people focus on her virtues and imitate them with filial affection.

**Papal Intention for May:** Pope Francis invites us to pray for Church Movements and Groups so that they may rediscover the mission of evangelisation each day and that they may place their charisms at the service of needs in the world. Authentic charisms "are gifts of the Spirit integrated into the body of the Church, drawn to the centre which is Christ and then channelled into an

evangelising impulse” (*Evangelii Gaudium*, 130). In this way, they must be marked by “conformity to and participation in the Church’s apostolic goals” and show “a missionary zeal which will increase their effectiveness as participants in a re-evangelisation” (*Christifideles Laici*, 30). Let us benevolently and prayerfully accompany the various ecclesial movements present in our Parishes, urging them to be authentic evangelizers.

**Our Duty to Vote:** The Karnataka State is due to go for elections on 10 May 2023. We need a Government that cares for the welfare of each citizen and brings about the development of all the areas of the State. We need to cast our valuable votes so that we get suitable candidates as our lawmakers who have the interests of the people at heart. Corruption is the greatest cancer eating up our society, and it is our bounden duty to select worthy leaders. Having an honest leader means a lot for the well-being of our society. The MLAs we choose will have a lot of influence in the selection of projects, approval of candidates for the local bodies, appointment or transfer of the members for the District Administration, the Police Personnel, and above all, they are called to facilitate peace and reconciliation among various contending groups.

Secular values upheld by the Constitution, like justice, liberty, equality, and fraternity, are to be nurtured, and the MLAs play a crucial role in the social fabric of our society. Therefore, I request the Parish Priests to urge everyone above 18 years whose names are already enrolled in the Voter’s list to exercise this inalienable right and duty to elect eligible candidates. In addition, the various groups can help bring people impeded by old age, infirmity or any other difficulty so that they exercise their voting right.

**Parish Priests are Custodians of the Church Property:** The parish is a Trust, and the Parish Priest is the Managing Trustee. Being a religious and charitable Trust, we have to pay the tax on time for the land and buildings. Besides, we are obliged to protect the property by fencing, or by constructing boundary walls so that

no encroachment takes place. Moreover, vacant land has to be used by planting saplings to make our surroundings green.

Also, keeping the property documents updated cannot be neglected. Those parishes that have not yet submitted the documents of the Church property, please do so as soon as possible. Kindly contact the Diocesan Estate Office for any information. Protecting the property of the Parish Trust and Institutions is the prime responsibility of the persons put in charge. Please do not forget that every pastor is also a custodian of the properties of the church/institution. He will be failing in his duty if he does not take care of the temporal goods of the parish.

**Documents Updated to Facilitate Transfers:** Since there are a good number of transfers, I ask the Priests to keep the records updated so that the newcomer won't encounter any problems carrying out the mission that has been assigned to him. Your prompt work will make it easier for auditors to complete audits on time during a transition period, and all of the hassles will be avoided.

**Priests on Transfer:** Priests who are being transferred will arrive at their new parish or organisation to start their new pastoral mission in the second half of May. All the priests who have been reassigned accept their mission with a disposition of willingness that goes far beyond the duty of obedience. There are numerous examples of priestly sacrifice for which we should be grateful. When a priest is transferred, we love and thank him for his service and wish him well. When a new priest arrives, we welcome him warmly and give him a chance. Our heartfelt gratitude goes to the lay faithful for loving and supporting the priests who are leaving, as well as welcoming those who will be arriving in May.

**Gifts to Children:** When children do well in Catechism or in any other activities, we have a good tradition of gifting them with Bibles. However, it may happen that copies of Bibles may be simply collected in the families without, however, opening them anymore. Besides the Bibles, we can also gift them with books

necessary for faith formation. Children of First Holy Communion could be gifted with the Children's Pictorial Bible wherever appropriate. The Youth, on the occasion of their Confirmation, can be given the YOUCAT Bible. Any material that helps the Children to imbibe the message of the Bible, or the teachings of the Church like YOUCAT is surely beneficial. Our focus must always be faith formation at a deeper level.

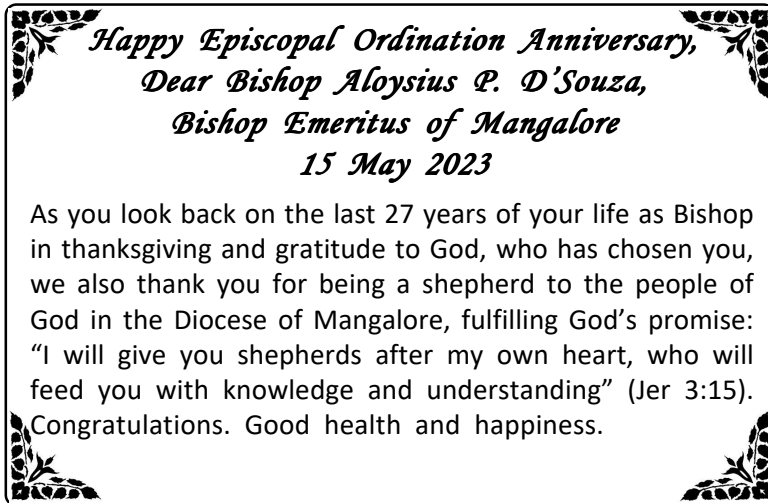
May Mary, the Star of Evangelization, intercede for us.

## **MOMENT OF MARIAN PRAYER FOR THE SYNOD**

The General Secretariat of the Synod in Rome has requested Episcopal Conferences worldwide to arrange for the celebration of a "Moment of Marian Prayer" on 31 May 2023 — the liturgical memorial of the Visitation of the Blessed Virgin Mary and the conclusion of the Marian Month — in preparation for and prayerful expectation of the XVI Ordinary General Assembly of the Synod of Bishops. The CCBI Office bearers, unanimously felt that, just as the inauguration of the Synodal Journey had taken place in each Diocese, this celebration too should be held in each Diocese on the indicated date, either in the Cathedral or in one or more Marian shrines of the territory. Therefore, we shall have the celebration of the "Moment of Marian Prayer" in our Diocese on Wednesday, **31 May 2023**, at Rosario Cathedral. I shall be celebrating the Holy Eucharist at Our Lady of Holy Rosary, Cathedral, at 7.00 a.m. I request all the Parish Priests and heads of the Institutions to have the Prayer in their respective Parishes and Institutions on the same day. The Prayer format will be sent to you soon. Let us pray through the intercession of Mother Mary that the forthcoming Synod on synodality may bear abundant fruits.
