# **BISHOP'S MESSAGE FOR JULY 2023**

**Papal Intention for July**: Pope Francis wants us to pray for the intention of inculcating a Eucharistic consciousness, that is, to make it the centre of Christian life, where we encounter God and our brothers and sisters. Pope Leo the Great said: "Our participation in the Body and Blood of Christ has no other end than to make us become that which we eat" (*Sermon* LXIII). Eucharist educates us to Christian life. When we celebrate it, the Eucharist forms and transforms us. We meet the Lord in a concrete and unique way there. May the Eucharist transform human relationships more profoundly. While we strongly condemn the atrocities committed against humanity in Manipur and in other parts of the world, let

us fall prostrate before the Eucharistic Lord so that he brings peace and harmony to heal the wounded world.

**Train the Faithful in Developing Eucharistic Consciousness:** Pope Francis writes in *Desiderio Desideravi*, n. 57: "it is of fundamental importance that the priests have a keen awareness of being, through God's mercy, a special presence of the risen Lord. The ordained minister is himself one of the types of presence of the Lord, which render the Christian assembly unique, different from any other assembly (*SC* 7)... To preside at Eucharist is to be immersed into the furnace of God's love". When we understand this reality, or grasp something of it, and celebrate the Eucharist devoutly, the assembly will be able to experience the ardent desire of the Lord to eat his Passover meal with his disciples. This month could be especially dedicated to train the people to participate and encounter the Lord in the Eucharist, using the insights given in the Apostolic Letter, *Desiderio Desideravi (DD*).

*Laudato Sì* Sunday: On July 2, we celebrate *Laudato Sì* Sunday in our Diocese. The Lord has been sending rain, and we start collaborating with him to care for our common home. This is the time where we can occupy ourselves with planting and nurturing the environment. I invite the Commission for Ecology and Environment to motivate all to do *Vrikshavandan* and *Jalabandan*, to conserve trees and water, which will preserve the richness of the soil, protect living creatures and humanity. *Laudato Sì* Sunday should not be a one-day event, but rather part of our daily life.

Annual Retreat: We have the first batch of Annual Retreat from 9 to 14 July. Retreat is a time to pray for the flock given to our care. What we cannot achieve by our own efforts, the Lord does it, when we take our needs before him in prayer. It goes without saying that silence is the time when we truly hear the voice of our Lord speaking to us. The highpoint of any day would be certainly the Eucharistic celebration, where "silence is not an inner haven in which to hide oneself in some sort of intimate isolation... Liturgical silence is something much more: it is a symbol of the presence and action of the Holy Spirit who animates the entire action of the celebration". Silence is "a symbol of the Spirit. It has the power to express the multifaceted action of the Spirit" (*DD* 52). I request the priests to come disposed to encounter the Lord in the Spiritual Exercises and experience the furnace of divine love of the heart of the Lord.

Third World Day of the Grandparents and Elderly, 23 July: The papal message for the day highlights the theme, "His mercy is from age to age" (Lk 1: 50). The Pope draws us to the realisation that what we are today is not so much about the securities or qualifications we possess but the values, character, culture and faith that are passed down from our elders and will continue for all posterity provided we cherish them.

This day and this month should be special for us to show gratitude to our grandparents and elders as we have inherited much from them. We are because they preceded us. We can reach out to them by showing our love and concern, by spending time listening to them, being patient with them even when it gets a bit tiresome, providing for their needs, telling them we really care, loving them through our words and deeds and above all pray with them and for them. Pope Francis invites the young people to visit their grandparents before they journey for World Youth Day and get blessed and protected through their prayers. He, in one of his interactions with the elderly, said: "The old and the young are the twin towers of the great suspension bridge which morally upholds our civilisation: the old represent Christianity's memory, and the young represent our future. Both are morally vital and a culture eager to discard both risks forfeiting the engines that drive it forward".

May the blessing of the loving embrace between elderly Elizabeth and the young Mother of God come upon us.

# *LAUDATO SÌ* SUNDAY: SOME IDEAS FOR ACTIVITIES

- 1. Response to the Cry of the Earth: >Turn off light sources when not needed; Replace lightbulbs with LED bulbs; Turn off electronics when not in use. >Open windows and use fans for cooling >Lower water consumption; Repair leaks quickly; Protect watersheds and wildlife; Increase tree canopy. > Develop a facilities plan for your parish or school to reduce emissions; Eliminate chemical fertilisers and pesticides.
- 2. Response to Cry of Those Who Are Poor/Vulnerable: > Explore local ecological educational opportunities in your community to learn about environmental issues. >Volunteer to do a parish clean-up; Volunteer with a local clean the waterways/rivers/ponds projects. >Assist vulnerable persons; Know your neighbours, develop relationships with one another; Run errands for those who need assistance in your neighbourhood.
- **3. Ecological Economics:** >Reduce food waste; Compost food scraps. >Build a parish 'go green' programme. >Buy locally produced and prepared food, patronise local farmers' market; Model healthy and just purchasing practices in all activities for

parishes and parish schools. >Improve access to nutritious foods; Build and eat-from-home gardens; Utilise public land to build community gardens.

- 4. Adoption of a Simple Lifestyle: >Cut down or eliminate single-use plastic (such as water bottles, and bags). > Buy less non-essentials; Cut down or eliminate foam-based food containers; Buy consciously: look for goods that have less packaging; support businesses that pay fair wages; Eat intentionally: go meat-free, buy local and in-season fruits and vegetables, or try growing your own; Waste less: avoid throwing away food whenever possible, and bring your own bags; Share more: such as a yard or house equipment, share your time by finding ways to volunteer or support community groups; Drive less: share a vehicle for grocery trips. Bicycle, walk, or use public transportation when possible. > Nurture your relationships; Examine your lifestyle for waste; Take time to pray and give thanks. >Implement an ecological purchasing system; Purchase supplies made from natural, recycled, or recyclable materials.
- 5. Ecological Education: > Organise local environmental educational trips; Find a nature preserve in the area. > F i n d recycling, energy production, and water treatment facilities.
  > Create or expand parish and school libraries to feature a variety of books that provide guidance and resources for this work and embrace the vision of *Laudato Si*. > Challenge children and youth to come up with local solutions to social and environmental problems and affirm the ideas they put forward.
  > Explore the connection between the environment and personal and communal health. > Develop *Laudato Si* inspired activities and theme days with practical follow-up actions.
- 6. Ecological Spirituality: >Homilies on pro-life values and integration of Catholic social and moral teaching regarding care for creation. >Highlight Catholic teaching throughout the year in a variety of formats: bulletin announcements, parish social media pages, youth ministry, Catechism and Adult Formation Programmes. >Bring in expert speakers to lead/guide conversations at parish or parish school-sponsored events. >Listen to a variety of voices, including/especially from those in marginalised communities. >Utilise parishioners and nongovernmental organisations (NGOs), who feature Catholic values, to speak on ecological issues. >Ensure parish and school events and formation opportunities promote the Church's teaching on climate change, social, racial, environmental, and migrant justice. >Empower parishioners to be active and engaged in the work of *Laudato S*.
