BISHOP'S MESSAGE FOR MAY 2024

The Papal Intention for May: Pope Francis invites us to pray that religious women, men and seminarians grow in their own vocation through their human, pastoral, spiritual and community formation leading them to be credible witnesses to the Gospel. The Church exists for evangelization. She needs true witnesses. The formation of the baptized as true witnesses is an indispensable task. The formation indicates following a singular 'journey of discipleship', which begins at Baptism, is perfected through the other sacraments of Christian Initiation, comes to be appreciated as the centre of one's life at the beginning of Seminary or religious formation, and continues through the whole of life. The formation houses should focus on forming 'missionary disciples' who are 'in love' with the Master. They must be shepherds 'with the smell of the sheep', who live in their midst to bring the mercy of God to them. Hence, every formee should always feel that he/she is a disciple on a journey, constantly needing an integrated formation, understood as a continuous configuration to Christ. People of our times look for such witnesses who resemble Christ. Let us pray that all of us truly become witnesses after the heart of Christ.

Month of Mother Mary: The Marian month invites us to dedicate our time to prayer. Being the Year of Prayer, this month urges us all the more to focus fervently on praying the Rosary and contemplate the mysteries of Christ and Mary, who is the epitome of the Church. Mother Mary herself is the model par excellence of Prayer. During her apparition at Fatima on 13 May 1917 and thereafter she gave a call to pray the Rosary for world peace. These days we witness that continuous missile attacks and bombardments from different fronts are shattering the world. People of one race are up in arms against another race and of one religion against another. The political leaders give open call to destroy the other for one's vested interests and have no qualms of conscience. May Mother Mary help this world, "the valley of tears". Please organize prayer meetings and Rosary meets for world peace.

Congratulations to the New Priests: I heartily congratulate the new priests, Fr Norman John Mathias, Fr Pradeep Clarence Rodrigues and Fr Lanson Maxim Pinto. I sincerely thank their Parents, Parish Priests, Formators, Ministry Guides and those involved in their formation. A special thanks to the Vicar General, Rector of the Cathedral, the Director of Mangala Jyothi, and all those who have helped in the celebration of ordination on 11 April 2024. I request everyone to pray for our priests so that they may give their best in the work of the Lord and for the Church.

Year of Study: The booklets on the Four Constitutions of the Second Vatican Council are available. Though 2023 was the Year of Study of these documents, we had little time left after the inauguration of the preparation for Jubilee 2025. May is a month when schools are closed. It is a good time for adults to study the Constitutions at the parish and deanery levels. The members of the Commissions for Bible, Proclamation and Evangelization, and Catechetics can study *Dei Verbum*, the Document on the Word of God. The Commissions for Liturgy and Seminary and Religious Vocation can study the various aspects of Liturgy (*Sacrosanctum Concilium*) to deepen the understanding of how liturgy forms our Christian life. Similarly, the Commissions for Social Communication, Justice and Peace, family and Youth can focus on the Church in the Modern World (*Gaudium et Spes*), and all Commissions can study on the fundamental document on the Church, *Lumen Gentium*. I request the Vicars Forane and Parish Priests to take leadership in forming the Commission Members using the material already published. Resource Persons are also available among Priests, Religious Sisters and Lay Faithful. You may contact the Staff from the Seminary.

Month of Transfers: The transfer of Priests begins from 6 May. There is excitement about going to a new place, meeting new people and beginning the mission there. There is a wonderful

practice of gratefully acknowledging the services of the outgoing Priest and gracefully welcoming the new Priest. The whole diocese is one family. While bidding farewell is painful, welcoming a new person is joyful. I request all Christ's faithful to welcome the Priests as Christ's ambassadors. I urge Priests to remember what you learnt in early formation: 'Leave the place better than you found it'. 'Leave memorable positive impressions as you go'. One might have developed attachments towards the place and persons after many years of collaborative work. However, as missionary disciples, we are called to leave the place as Abraham was asked to do and go to the place the Lord has chosen for us.

Pray for the Rain: Though we had some sporadic showers, the rise of global temperature is alarming. We must pray unceasingly for good rain this year. In *Laudate Deum*, Pope Francis reminds us to work with the global community to reduce the temperature by reducing the use of fossil fuels. He invites us to collaborate with every effort towards the use of clean energy by changing our lifestyle. The Pope says: "the need to realize that there are no lasting changes without cultural changes, without a maturing of lifestyles and convictions within societies, and there are no cultural changes without personal changes" (n. 70). Let us find ways and means to reduce the temperature by using less and less fossil fuels, and also by planting more saplings during the rainy season and do the water harvesting.

First World Children's Day, 25-26 May: Pope Francis has declared that the First World Children's Day is going to be celebrated in this month in Rome. He has chosen the theme: "Behold, I make all things new" (Rev 21:5). In his message, he invites the children to pray "to become builders of a new, more humane, just and peaceful world". They have to pray the prayer Jesus taught us, the *Our Father*, in the morning and in the evening together with the parents, grandparents, brothers and sisters. In the language of the children, the Pope talks of a secret

to be happy: “If we really want to be happy, we need to pray, to pray a lot, to pray every day, because prayer connects us directly to God. Prayer fills our hearts with light and warmth; it helps us to do everything with confidence and peace of mind”. Let us encourage the children to pray the Our Father in the morning and in the evening in order to build a better and more humane world.

May the Queen of the Holy Rosary intercede for all the families in the world.

Whereas if bitterness and compunction are directed not to the world but to our own hearts, the Lord will not fail to visit us and raise us up. That is exactly what the Imitation of Christ tells us to do: “Busy yourself not about the affairs of others, and do not become entangled in the business of your superiors. Keep an eye primarily on yourself, and admonish yourself instead of your friends. If you do not enjoy the favour of men, do not let it sadden you; yet consider it a serious matter if you do not conduct yourself as well or as carefully as is becoming” (Pope Francis, Chrism Mass Homily, 28.03.2024).

A Bird's Eye View of the Declaration of the Dicastery for the Doctrine of the Faith *Dignitas Infinita* on Human Dignity

The new document *Dignitas infinita* of the Dicastery for the Doctrine of the Faith, published on 8 April 2024, builds on the papal magisterium of the last decade: from war to poverty, from violence against migrants to violence against women, from abortion to surrogate motherhood and euthanasia, from gender theory to digital violence.

The main innovation of the document, the result of five years of work, is the inclusion of a number of key bioethical issues. Abortion, euthanasia and surrogate motherhood, along with war, poverty and human trafficking, are included in the “non-exhaustive” list of violations of human dignity.

The first three parts of the Declaration recall fundamental principles. It strongly affirms “the ontological dignity of human beings, created in God’s image and redeemed in Jesus Christ”. The document highlights the misunderstandings of those who prefer the expression “personal dignity” to “human dignity,” since they understand a person only as ‘one who is capable of reasoning. The document also reveals that the concept of human dignity is sometimes misused to justify an arbitrary proliferation of new rights.

The Declaration then lists “some grave offenses against human dignity”. These include not only all offenses against life itself, such as murder, genocide, abortion, euthanasia, and willful suicide, but also all violations of the integrity of the human person, such as mutilation, physical and mental torture, and undue psychological pressure. Finally, it includes all offenses against human dignity, such as subhuman living conditions, arbitrary imprisonment, deportation, slavery, prostitution, the sale of women and children, degrading working conditions in which human beings are treated as mere tools for profit rather than as free and responsible persons.

The first issue mentioned is poverty, “one of the greatest injustices in the contemporary world”. Then there is war, “another tragedy that denies human dignity”, and always a “defeat of humanity”. Then there is the “travail of migrants,” whose lives

are in danger because they no longer have the means to raise a family, to work, or to feed themselves. It then discusses human trafficking, the sale of human organs and tissues, the sexual exploitation of boys and girls, slave labour, including prostitution, drug and arms trade, terrorism, and international organized crime.

The condemnation of abortion is strong. The document rejects surrogacy, through which “the child becomes a mere object”, and reaffirms that “a child is always a gift and never the basis of a commercial contract”. It also rejects euthanasia and assisted suicide, mentions the importance of palliative care and the avoidance of “aggressive treatments or disproportionate medical procedures,” and affirms that “life is a right, not death, to be welcomed, not administered”.

The document begins the section on gender theory by emphasizing that “any sign of unjust discrimination” against homosexual persons “must be carefully avoided, especially any form of aggression and violence. Gender theory denies the greatest possible difference that exists between living beings: sexual difference. While it judges sex change negatively, it allows the possibility that a person with genital anomalies that are evident at birth or that develop later may choose to seek the assistance of health professionals to resolve these anomalies.

The final item on the list is “digital violence”: It says: “Consider, for example, how easy it is through these means to endanger a person’s good name with fake news and slander ... “it is not healthy to confuse communication with mere virtual contact. Indeed, the digital environment is also one of loneliness, manipulation, exploitation, and violence, even to the extreme case of the ‘dark web.’ Digital media can expose people to the risk of addiction, isolation, and gradual loss of contact with concrete reality, blocking the development of authentic interpersonal relationships. New forms of violence are spreading through social media, for example, cyberbullying. The internet is also a channel for spreading pornography and the exploitation of persons for sexual purposes or through gambling.”

The Declaration *Dignitas Infinita* concludes by stating that the commitment to human rights is never finished! It also urges that “respect for the dignity of the human person, beyond all circumstances, be placed at the centre of the commitment to the common good and at the centre of every legal system”. □
