## BISHOP'S MESSAGE FOR MAY 2025

**Prayer Intention for May:** Pope Francis had invited the whole Church to pray for the improvement of the living conditions of the working class. Through work, each family finds a dignified life and fulfilment, the society gets humanized and the whole world learns to be compassionate seeing the hardship of workers. The tragedy of today is that many do not find adequate employment and life becomes burdensome due to lack of resources. In other places, there aren't adequate working conditions favourable for the wholesome growth. May this month help us focus on the life and contribution of the working class and let us pray that the rights of the workers, especially of the unorganized sector be respected.

**Marian Month:** The month of May, dedicated to Mother Mary, reminds us of her apparitions at Fatima in 1917. During the First World War Mary appeared to the three children and promised peace provided people repented. Today once again quite a few countries are on war. Human life is devalued. Russia is once again in the news for war with Ukraine. Mother Mary then invited to consecrate Russia and the whole world to her Immaculate Heart. Our heavenly Mother's ears are very attentive to our prayers. Let us continue to pray for Russia and Ukraine, Israel and Gaza and many other countries affected by war. I request you to pray the Rosary every day, so that peace may prevail in this broken world. May Marian devotions lead us to Jesus the prince of peace.

**World Day of Prayer for Vocations:** Vocation Sunday invites us to pray for priestly and religious vocations (May 11, 2025). While I congratulate the newly ordained Priests, Fr Melvin D'Souza, Fr Jeevan Shailesh Lobo, Fr Marwin Praveen Lobo, Fr Avith Pais and Fr Vikas Pereira for their generous self-offering, I invite all to pray for them that they may remain faithful to the Lord all through their life. I sincerely thank their Parents, Parish Priests who accompanied them in their life's journey, the Formators in the Seminaries and all the benefactors who have contributed towards their formation. I specially thank the Parish Priest of Alangar Parish and his team who made all the necessary arrangements for the ceremony of ordination and all who have contributed in one way or the other.

**Transfer of Priests and New Mission:** In this month and in the next, transfers of Priests take place. It is a grace-filled moment for Priests to recall all the good the Lord has done through them in the particular Parish or Institution they have been serving and now they are called to serve in another portion of the Diocese. Dear Brother Priests, the transfers do bring emotion-filled moments, because the people have loved you and you have loved them, and therefore, parting becomes painful. I am sure you will cherish a lot of joyful moments and remember the challenges you had to face and all these have enriched you. ## **A NOTE TO PARISH PRIESTS UNDERGOING TRANSFER**

In our diocese, most transfers of Parish Priests take place during May and June. Chartered Accountants (CAs) are generally unable to complete the audit of annual accounts before this period. According to diocesan norms, audited financial statements must be presented to the Parish Finance Council (PFC), Parish Pastoral Council (PPC), and Parish Assembly (PA). Given these circumstances, Parish Priests scheduled for transfer are urged to observe the following guidelines:

- 1) Parish Priests may obtain a draft copy of the statements of accounts from the Chartered Accountant (CA), present it to the Parish Finance Council (PFC) for review, and gather suggestions for any necessary corrections or clarifications. The CA should then be informed of the required changes.
- 2) Chartered Accountants will be able to complete the audit of the accounts only after receiving feedback from the Parish Priests regarding any required rectifications. This process may not be completed prior to the transfers.
- 3) According to the Constitution of the Councils, the audited accounts must be presented at the meetings of the Parish Finance Council (PFC), Parish Pastoral Council (PPC), and, as specified, the Parish Assembly (PA). Therefore, the new Parish Priest assuming responsibility for the parish is required to present the audited accounts at these meetings and facilitate the resolution for their approval or acceptance.
- 4) Therefore, please ensure that when submitting the reports of the PFC, PPC, and PA to the Bishop for review, along with the annual returns and other annexures, the dates of the meetings where the accounts are presented to these councils/bodies should be after the dates listed in the Chartered Accountant's audit report. In other words, the new Parish Priest must present the final audited annual accounts to the

councils, obtain final approval, and then submit the accounts to the Bishop for review.

- 5) Parish Priests who are not being transferred in the current year are also expected to follow the process outlined above.

## INTRODUCING THE NEWLY ORDAINED PRIESTS OF THE DIOCESE OF MANGALORE

Five joyful deacons - Avith Pais, Jeevan Shailesh Lobo, Marwin Praveen Lobo, Melvin D'Souza and Vikas Pereira - from the Diocese of Mangalore completed a significant milestone in their vocational journey as they were ordained to the Presbyterate on Wednesday, April 30, 2025. The Presbyteral Ordination took place at Our Lady of the Rosary Church in Alangar, Moodbidri, and was conferred by the Most Rev. Peter Paul Saldanha, Bishop of Mangalore.

The solemn ceremony was witnessed by a large congregation comprising priests, religious, and lay faithful from various parishes of the diocese. Holding the ordination outside Mangalore City as per the request of the newly ordained priests, offered both convenience and opportunity for wider participation in this momentous and grace-filled event.

The celebration was a beautiful testament to the vibrant faith of the Diocese of Mangalore and a sign of hope that the call to serve in the priesthood continues to inspire dedicated responses.

Now, we introduce you to the newest priests of the diocese:

1. **Rev. Avith Pais** hails from the Sacred Heart of Jesus Parish, Maril. Born on April 27, 1997, he is the beloved son of Anthony and Gracy Pais and he has one younger brother. He completed his high school education at St Philomena High School, Puttur, followed by his Pre-University studies at Rosario PU College, Mangalore. He then pursued a Bachelor of Arts degree at St Philomena College, Puttur. His formative journey in the seminary included a regency year at St Anthony Church, Naravi and diaconal ministry at Mary, Queen of the Universe Church, Ranipura. Fr Avith has shown a deep interest and aptitude in family apostolate, Basic Ecclesial Communities (BECs) and children's catechesis — areas that reflect his pastoral heart and missionary spirit. His priestly motto, drawn from 1 Corinthians 10:31, is: "All for the glory of God."

2. **Rev. Jeevan Shailesh Lobo** belongs to St Martin De Porres Parish, Belvai. Born on July 30, 1996, he is the youngest child of John and Celestine Lobo, with an elder brother and sister. He completed his high school education at Shri Kantheshwara High School, Kanthavara, and pursued his Pre-University studies at Jain PU College, Moodbidri. He then earned a Bachelor of Science (B.Sc.) degree from St Philomena College, Puttur. Jeevan's regency was at Our Lady of Remedies Church, Kirem, and he served his diaconal ministry at Guardian Angel Church, Angelore. He has a special inclination towards youth ministry and social communication, which reflects his dynamic and engaging pastoral approach. His priestly motto, inspired by Philippians 4:13, is: "I can do all things through Him who strengthens me."

3. **Rev. Marwin Praveen Lobo** is from Holy Rosary Parish, Alangar, Moodbidri, and was born on May 19, 1997. He is the son of Edwin and Helen Lobo and is the eldest of three siblings, with one brother and one sister. He completed his high school education at Adarsh High School, Taccode, followed by Pre-University studies at Rosario PU College, Mangalore. He pursued his Bachelor of Arts (B.A.) degree at St Philomena College, Puttur. While he has an interest in social media and communication, Marwin also expresses a strong inclination toward prison ministry and service to the poor and downtrodden — areas he sees as vital components of his priestly mission. He completed his regency at St Monica Church, Kumbala, and served his diaconal ministry at St John the Baptist Church, Kokkada. His inspirational motto, guiding his priestly life and ministry, comes from John 15:16: "You did not choose me, I chose you."

4. **Rev. Melvin D'Souza** hails from Our Lady of the Holy Rosary Parish, Nidpalli. He was born on January 23, 1995, to Balthazar and Stella D'Souza, and has two younger brothers. He completed his high school education at Prathibha High School, Patte, followed by Pre-University studies at Rosario PU College, Mangalore. He earned a Bachelor's degree in Social Work (BSW) from St Philomena College, Puttur. Fr Melvin pursued his

theological formation at the Pontifical Urban University in Rome, where he also completed a Licentiate in Philosophy. He has a special interest in philosophy, formation, and pastoral ministry among children and young adults. His regency was at St Anthony's Church, Naravi, and he served his diaconal ministry at Mother of God Church, Mogarnad.

5. **Rev. Vikas Pereira** belongs to Holy Cross Parish, Hosabettu. He was born on October 2, 1996, and is the youngest child of Victor and Leena Pereira, with an elder sister and brother. He completed his high school education at Jain High School, Moodbidri, followed by Pre-University studies at Rosario PU College, Mangalore. He later earned a Bachelor of Arts (B.A.) degree from St Philomena College, Puttur. Fr Vikas completed his regency at the Pastoral Institute, Shanthi Kiran, Bajjodi, Mangalore, and served his diaconal ministry at Our Lady of Pompei Church, Gurpur. He sees liturgical ministry, preaching, and active involvement in parish pastoral commissions as essential aspects of a wholesome parish ministry. He also has a deep interest in ministering to the shut-ins, the sick, and the elderly, believing that these reflect the spirit of an "outreaching Church." His priestly motto, taken from Acts 9:15-16, is: "You are my chosen instrument."

These five newly ordained priests now begin their sacred ministry, ready to serve the people of God with humility, zeal, and love. As they embark on this new chapter in their priestly journey, the diocese rejoices with them and lifts them up in prayer that their path may be filled with grace, strength, and unwavering faith. We extend our heartfelt congratulations and best wishes to our new priests as they begin their ministry and journey through priestly life. May their lives remain deeply rooted in God and centred around the people they are called to serve.

Pope Francis, who passed away on April 21, 2025, reminds us that every priest is invited to be a source of blessing for his people. The anointing received at ordination is not meant solely for the priest himself — it is to flow through him to those he

serves. As the Holy Father beautifully said during his homily at the ordination Mass in St. Peter's Basilica on April 25, 2021:

“Be the shepherds of the holy faithful people of God. Shepherds who go with the people of God: sometimes in front of the flock, sometimes in the middle or behind, but always there, with the people of God. Once upon a time – in the language of the past – we spoke of an ‘ecclesiastical career’, which did not have the same meaning as it does today. This is not a ‘career’: it is a service, a service like the one God did for his people. And this service of God to his people has ‘traces’, it has a style, a style that you must follow. A style of closeness, a style of compassion and a style of tenderness. This is God’s style: closeness, compassion, tenderness.”

May God the Father renew in each of us the Spirit of holiness with whom we have been anointed. And may our new priests be instruments of that holiness, joy, and gladness wherever they are sent.
